*A Concert for Winter* invites Southwark schools and community groups to come and perform on stage at Shakespeare's Globe.

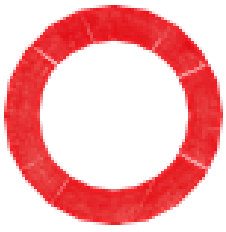

We suggest that you propose a **first choice** and a **second choice** piece to perform so that we have flexibility in putting together a varied and well-balanced programme. Please be aware that we reserve the right to make the final decision as to which of your song choices is most appropriate for our programme and that you will be accepted on the basis of this song: substitutions will not be permitted. **Contributions should last no more than four minutes.** The music can be classical or contemporary, international or local. **Please note: it is not possible to use electric instruments or recordings on the Globe Stage. All music must be performed acoustically by your group.**

**13.00 – 14.00:** Final performance

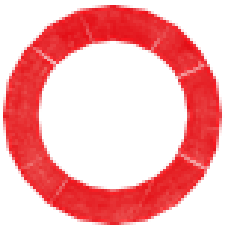

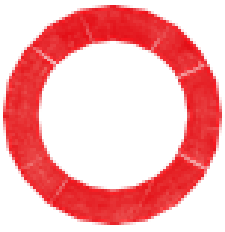
