We believe all children, regardless of age, disability, gender, racial heritage, religious belief, sexual orientation or identity, have an equal right to protection from abuse or neglect.

We recognise that some of the adults who use our services are vulnerable to abuse and neglect in the same way. We are determined to provide this group with a safe and stimulating experience at Shakespeare's Globe.

We make sure our staff and volunteers are recruited safely and that all the necessary checks are done.

We believe that working in partnership with children, young people, their parents, carers and other agencies is essential in promoting the welfare of children and young people.

We provide effective management and support for staff and volunteers through supervision and training.

When concerns about children arise we will deal with them sensitively, sharing them only with the agencies who need to know, and involving families as appropriate.
